- 5. Sons of Norway activities and events in which you have taken part.
- 6. Essay of not more than 250 words, describing your current understanding of your career goals, how you plan to pursue them and how your studies will honor the Scholarship and the Sons of Norway.
- 7. Recent photo (headshot) no smaller than 3 inches wide by 4 inches high.
